## MEMPHIS AVIATION GROUP SUPPORTS HISTORIC FLIGHT

MEMPHIS, TN, OCTOBER 24, 2008: The Memphis Squadron of the Commemorative Air Force is pleased to announce that it will be providing support to the first transcontinental flight of an aircraft powered by biofuel. The aircraft, owned by THH Inc. of Santa Ana, CA and piloted by the company's founder, Mr. Len Johnson will depart on Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> on a flight from the west coast to the east coast. The flight will terminate in Kitty Hawk, North Carolina which is the location of the Wright Brothers first flights.

The aircraft will overnight in Memphis and refuel at the Memphis Squadron's facility before continuing on to Kitty Hawk. There will be availability to the media prior to the aircraft's departure.
